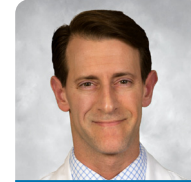

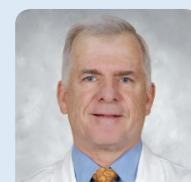

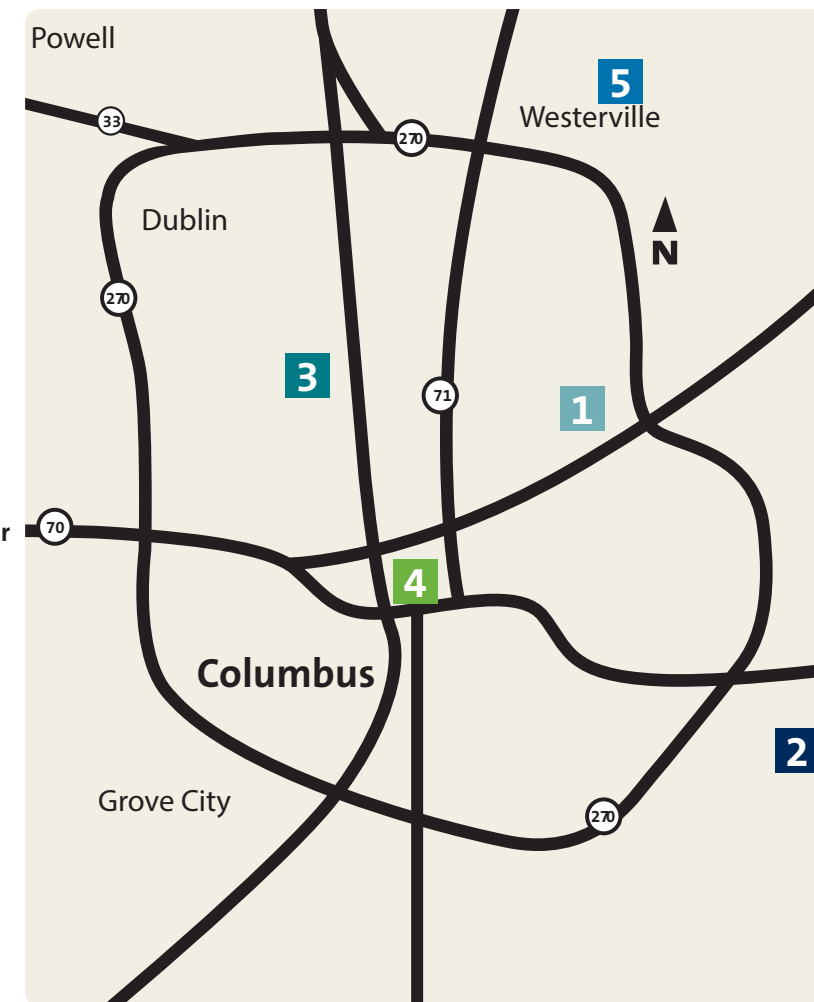

*At OhioHealth, your patient has access to a team of surgeons who are specialists in the treatment of patients with colorectal cancer. We work closely with you and a multidisciplinary team of cancer specialists to provide comprehensive and compassionate care for your patient, keeping care as close to home as possible.*

**Our surgeons evaluate, diagnose and treat the entire spectrum of both benign and malignant diseases involving the colon (large bowel), rectum and anus including:**

- + Anorectal disorders (hemorrhoids, abscesses, fissures and fistulas)
- + Pelvic conditions (fecal incontinence, constipation)
- + Inflammatory bowel disease (Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis)
- + Colon and rectal cancers



## Colorectal Cancer Care

Colorectal cancer is one of the most common types of cancer diagnosed and treated at OhioHealth and we treat the most colorectal cancers in central Ohio. This experience, combined with our patient-focused approach, advanced technology, innovative programs, expert caregivers and screening facilities conveniently located throughout central Ohio, makes OhioHealth the premier choice for colorectal cancer treatment in the region.

**Surgical services we offer include:**

- + Traditional surgery
- + Laparoscopic surgery
- + Robotic-assisted surgery
- + Cutting-edge TransAnal Minimally Invasive Surgery (TAMIS) and TransAnal Endoscopic Microsurgery (TEM) for rectal tumors, both highly specialized, sphincter-sparing procedures

## Collaborative and Comprehensive Care

Our colon and rectal surgeons collaborate with OhioHealth medical oncologists, radiation oncologists and other cancer specialists to determine the best treatment plan for each patient. We offer these services at several locations throughout the region, keeping patients as close to home as possible.

### Medical Oncology

Chemotherapy and targeted therapies are highly individualized. Your patient's medical oncologist will work with his or her colorectal cancer care team to determine the most effective treatment plan and monitor patient care. Our outpatient infusion centers offer a comfortable, convenient setting for treatment. Patients may even be able to use the time to meet with their patient navigator or, in some locations, receive massage therapy, art therapy and other services.

We also offer targeted therapies at our infusion centers, along with other key drug treatments for colorectal cancer. Targeted therapies block the growth and spread of cancer by interfering with specific molecules. Not all tumors have the same molecules, so targeted therapy does not work for every person.

### Radiation Oncology

Radiation therapy is unique to each individual and directed by the radiation oncologist. All OhioHealth radiation therapy locations have real-time access to your patient's care plan, so appointments can be scheduled at whatever location is most convenient.

### Interventional Radiology

OhioHealth interventional radiologists are specially trained in advanced treatments and procedures that use image-guided therapies for difficult-to-treat tumors. Often referred to as interventional oncology, this treatment is one of the newest and most aggressive options in cancer treatment today. It targets and treats cancers that cannot be treated surgically by using heating, cooling or microwave energy to kill tumor cells. Patients benefit from low-risk complications and may even return home the same day they receive treatment.



## Multidisciplinary Treatment Conference

The OhioHealth Multidisciplinary Treatment Conference is an approach to treatment planning where experts from our cancer care team meet to review and discuss your patient's medical condition and treatment options. Unique cases may also be presented to the MD Anderson Multidisciplinary Planning Conference for review and input.

## Supportive Care

To help your patient manage their care, restore their sense of well-being and overcome the challenges of living with cancer, your patient's oncology-trained navigator will connect them with a range of supportive care services.

### Navigation

Every patient has access to a dedicated, oncology-trained navigator who will connect them with valuable services, education and support.

### Integrative Care

Integrative care is a physician-directed, evidence-based program that focuses on healing the whole person and draws on the fields of nutrition, stress management, physical fitness, massage therapy, acupuncture and many other nontraditional therapies.

### Clinical Trials

OhioHealth actively participates in research networks worldwide, and also has access to clinical trials through our relationship with MD Anderson Cancer Center®. This puts our cancer research program at the forefront of cancer care, offering the latest treatments and therapies.

Our patients have been included in 12 clinical trials for colon cancer, and OhioHealth has participated in two of those studies. On average, 8 percent of our patients are approved to participate in clinical trials, compared with the national average of less than 3 percent.

### Survivorship

We help patients prepare for a healthy life after cancer treatment by providing them with information and resources about nutrition and fitness, ostomy clinics, and cancer wellness and support opportunities.
